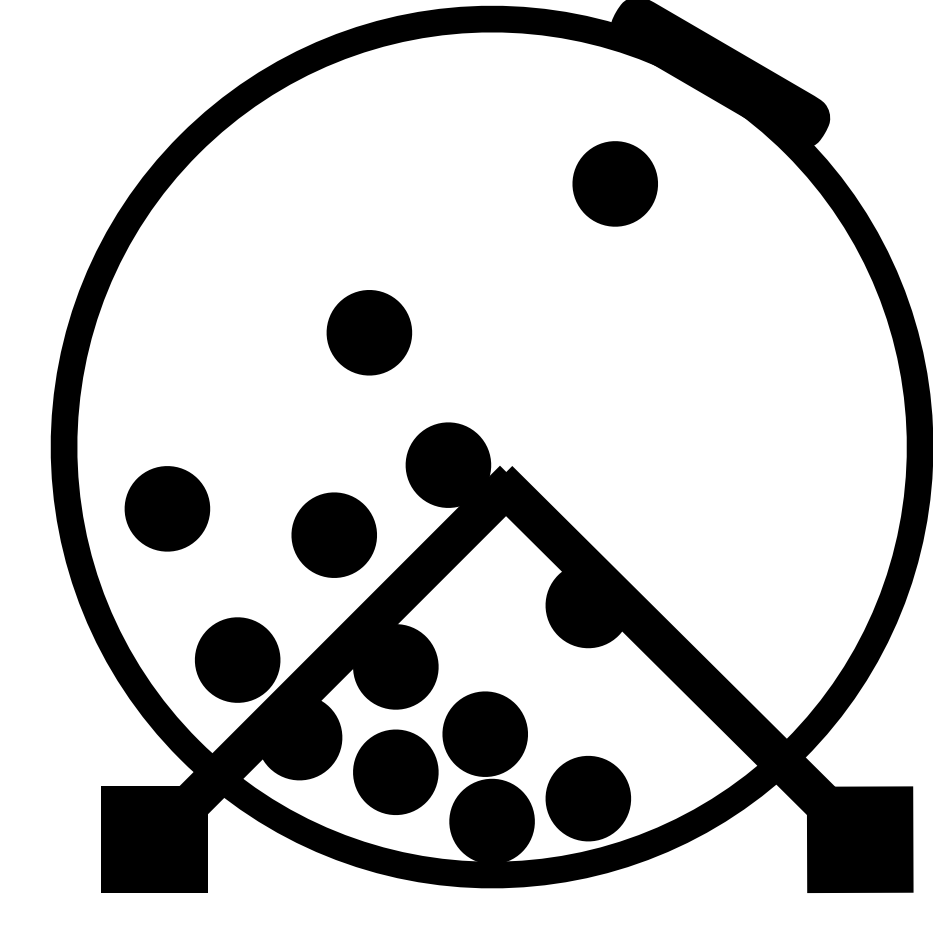

The University of Toronto charges a \$125 Application Fee to process graduate applications. The Psychology Department encourages applications from people who identify as Indigenous, Black, or racialized; 2SLGBTQ+; living with disability; a first-generation student (i.e. people who were the first in their families to attend university); and living on a low income. The Application Fee Waiver Program is meant to further encourage these applicants by potentially waiving their application fees. However, everyone who needs a waiver is eligible!

How will the Application Fee Waivers be distributed?

Application Fee Waivers will be distributed through a "Stratified Lottery" that has 3 priority waves.



Wave 1

- Indigenous applicants
- Black applicants
- Gender minorities

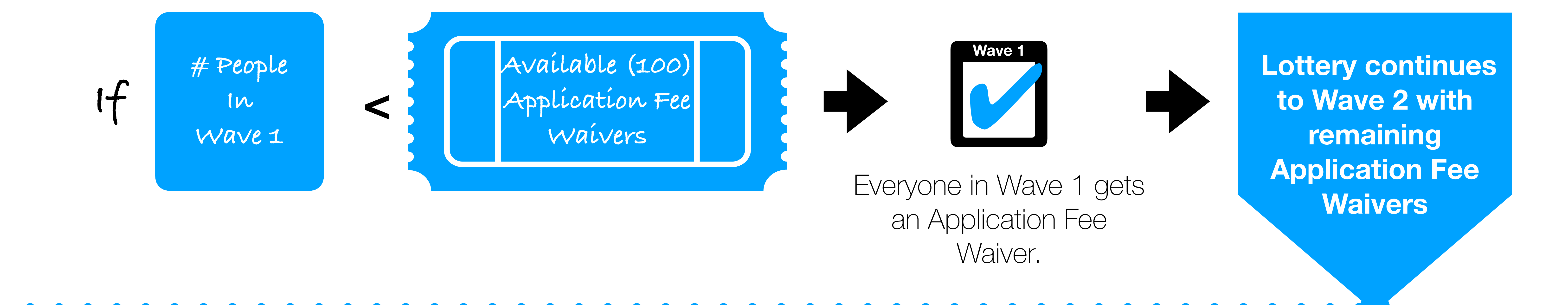
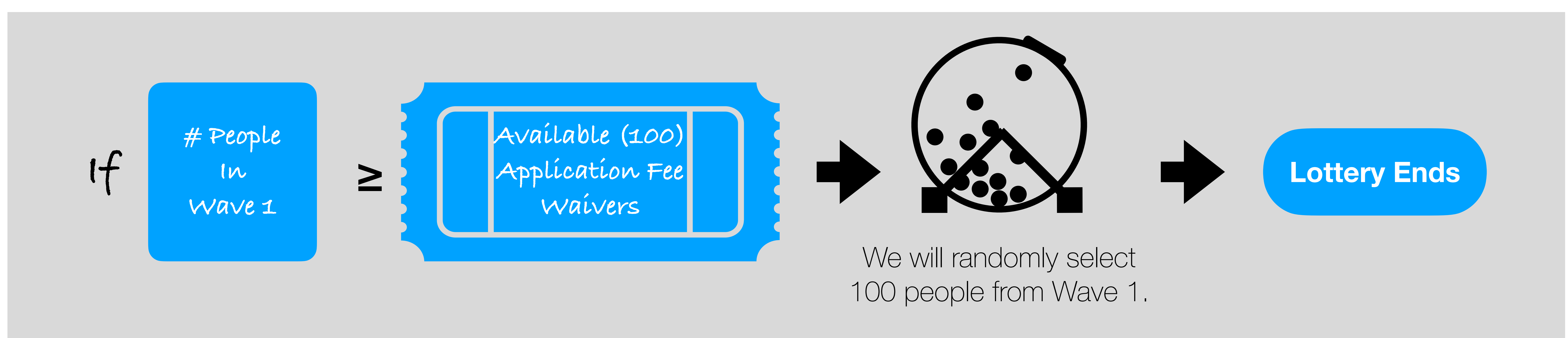
Wave 2

- All other applicants who identify as racialized
- All other applicants who identify as 2SLGBTQ+
- Applicants living with disabilities
- First-generation university student applicants
- Applicants with extreme financial need (annual household income \leq \$20,000 CAD)

Wave 3

- All other applicants who need a fee waiver
